TO: (A) THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE; (B) THE HOLDERS OF THE TWENTY-FIVE (25) LARGEST UNSECURED CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEBTOR; (C) COUNSEL TO THE PREPETITION AND POSTPETITION LENDER; (D) THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE; AND (E) ANY PARTY THAT REQUESTS SERVICE PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY RULE 2002

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that, on April 13, 2020, the above-captioned debtor and debtor in possession (the "**Debtor**") filed the *Debtor's Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders Authorizing (I) the Debtor to Honor and Refund Certain Customer Obligations; and (II) Banks to Honor and Process Check and Electronic Transfer Requests Related Thereto* [Docket No. 5] (the "**Motion**") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "**Court**").

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, on April 15, 2020, the Court held a hearing (the "**Initial Hearing**") to consider the approval of the relief requested in the Motion on an interim basis. At the Initial Hearing, the Court instructed the Debtor to schedule the Motion for a subsequent hearing to consider its approval on a final basis. A proposed form of order granting the relief requested in the Motion on a final basis is attached to the Motion as Exhibit B.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, accordingly, a hearing to consider approval of the Motion on a final basis will be held on **May 13, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. (ET)** before the

At the same time, you must serve a copy of the objection upon the undersigned proposed counsel to the Debtor so as to be received on or before the Objection Deadline.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT IF YOU FAIL TO RESPOND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS NOTICE, THEN THE COURT MAY GRANT THE RELIEF REQUESTED IN THE MOTION WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE OR A HEARING.**
