**Proceedings: [IN CHAMBERS] ORDER REGARDING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

The Court issued a temporary restraining order in this matter on June 14, 2019 (“TRO”), and a hearing took place on June 24. The Plaintiff presented ample evidence showing good cause to extend the TRO until July 10, 2019 with certain alterations (as noted in this Order) and subject to any papers Defendants may file. *See* Rule 65(b)(2).

Defendants may have until **July 1, 2019 at noon** to file an Opposition to the TRO, and Plaintiff may have until **July 3 at noon** to file a Reply. The preliminary injunction hearing is continued to **July 8, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.** The Defendants’ deadline to provide an accounting (*see* TRO at ¶ 9) is extended to **July 1, 2019 at noon**.

The Court also finds good cause to appoint a receiver. *See generally* Recommendation, Dkt. 4. The Court’s handwritten notations on the caption page and signature page of the TRO (Dkt. 15 at 1, 15) are STRICKEN, and the Court appoints Jeffrey E. Brandlin as the receiver in this case. Based on the representations of counsel, a receiver’s bond is unnecessary at this time. Except as otherwise stated in this Order, the TRO remains in effect until July 10, 2019 at noon.
