NOTICE OF SALE AND SALE HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. On November 1, 2020, FIC Restaurants, Inc. and its debtor affiliates, as debtors and debtors in possession (each a "<u>Debtor</u>," and collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>") filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "<u>Bankruptcy Court</u>") their motion [Docket No. 19] (the "<u>Motion</u>") for the entry of: (i) an order (the "<u>Procedures Order</u>"), approving (a) the procedures (the "<u>Assignment Procedures</u>") for the assumption and assignment of certain executory contracts and unexpired leases of nonresidential real property of the Debtors (collectively, the "<u>Contracts and Unexpired Leases</u>") in connection to the private sale (the "<u>Sale</u>") of substantially all of the Debtors' assets (the "<u>Assets</u>") to Amici Partners Group, LLC (the "<u>Purchaser</u>"), an entity affiliated with BRIX Holdings, LLC; (b) scheduling a hearing (the "<u>Sale Hearing</u>") to consider approval of the Sale of Assets to Purchaser, including the assumption and assignment of the Contracts and Unexpired Leases; (c) approving the form and manner of notices thereof; and (d) granting related relief; and (ii) an order (the "<u>Sale Order</u>") authorizing and approving (a) that certain Purchase Agreement; (b) the Sale of Assets to Purchaser free and clear of liens, claims, rights, encumbrances, and other interests; (c) the assumption and assignment of certain Contracts and Unexpired Leases; and (d) granting related relief.
- 2. On November 16, 2020, the Bankruptcy Court entered the Procedures Order [Docket No. 117].

Sontchi, United States Bankruptcy Judge, 824 North Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, 5th Floor, Courtroom #6, on **December 17, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.** (ET), or at such other time thereafter as counsel may be heard. The Sale Hearing may be adjourned by the Debtors from time to time without further notice to creditors or other parties in interest other than by announcement of the adjournment in open court on the date scheduled for the Sale Hearing or by filing a notice, which may be a hearing agenda stating the adjournment, on the docket of the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases.
- Any objections to the Sale or the relief requested in connection with the Sale, including objections to entry of the proposed Sale Order (a "Sale Objection"), except for a Cure Cost/Assignment Objection (which shall be governed by the Assignment Procedures), must: (i) be in writing; (ii) be signed by counsel or attested to by the objecting party; (iii) conform to the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Rules and the Local Rules; (iv) state with particularity the legal and factual basis for the objection and the specific grounds therefor; (v) be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, 824 N.
