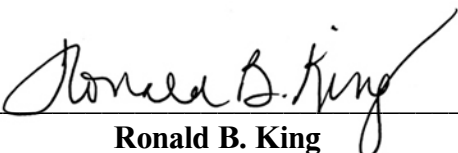

**ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR FILING CLAIMS ARISING FROM
REJECTION OF EXECUTORY CONTRACTS OR UNEXPIRED LEASES
AND AUTHORIZING DEBTORS TO SERVE NOTICE OF THAT DEADLINE**

The Court has considered Debtors' Motion (the "Motion")² for Order Setting Deadline for Filing Claims Arising from Rejection of Executory Contracts or Unexpired Leases, and finds that notice was proper and that no party in interest made any response in opposition to the Motion or,

if so, the relief requested in any such response was denied for the reasons stated on the record, and further finds that the relief requested in the Motion should be granted.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED, as set forth herein.
2. The deadline for the Affected Counterparties to file Proofs of Claim related to rejection of their respective contract or lease with the Debtors shall be the latter of (a) August 1, 2016, or (b) thirty (30) days after the date of entry of an Order approving the rejection of the respective contract or lease.
3. The Debtors are authorized to file and serve a Notice of Deadline for Filing Proofs of Claim Pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c)(4) and 3003(c)(3), substantially in the form attached to the Motion as Exhibit B, on the Affected Counterparties.
4. This Order shall not impact the Current Bar Date(s) previously established for creditors other than the Affected Counterparties. [*See* Docket #122].
