ORDER SCHEDULING EXPEDITED HEARING

Upon the motion (the “Motion”) of the above-captioned Debtor and Debtor in possession (the “Debtor”) for the entry of an order (this “Order”) scheduling an expedited hearing on the Debtor’s Critical First Day Matters; and it appearing that the relief requested therein is in the best interests of the Debtor’s estate, its creditors and other parties in interest; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that notice of the Motion and opportunity for a hearing on the Motion was appropriate under the particular circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
2. A hearing will be held on the Critical First Day Matters on **March 4, 2020 at 12:00 p.m.** (prevailing Eastern time) before the Honorable Magdeline D. Coleman, Chief U.S. Bankruptcy Judge, presiding at the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Courthouse, 900 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107, courtroom No. 2.
3. Objections to any of the Critical First Day Matters may be raised by creditors and parties in interest at such hearing.

4. The Debtor shall serve a Notice of Expedited Hearing and copies of the Critical First Day Matters in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 1002-2(d)(2) and file a Certificate of Service prior to the hearing on the Critical First Day Matters.
