

Proof of Claim and Bar Date FAQ for Ruby's Employees

1. I received something in the mail, what is it?

You have likely received the NOTICE OF BAR DATE FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM IN A CHAPTER 11 CASE or Bar Date Notice.

2. What is the Bar Date Notice?

The Bar Date Notice provides the date by which proofs of claim must be filed. In this case, Monday, June 3, 2019.

3. What is a Proof of Claim form?

A Proof of Claim form is the document that must be completed and submitted by a creditor to assert a monetary claim against the Company.

4. What is a "Claim"?

A "claim" is a right to a payment, or debt owed.

5. Does this mean Ruby's owes me money?

No. The Bar Date Notice is sent as a matter of course to all potential creditors, including employees. Unless you have a claim to assert, no action is required on your part.
