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**SCHEDULING ORDER**

The Court hereby schedules an emergency telephonic hearing for **July 16, 2020 at 3:30 p.m.** (the “Hearing”) regarding the following motions:

- i. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC for Use of Cash Collateral [Dkt. No. 5];
- ii. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (A) Authorizing Debtors to Use Existing Cash Management System; (B) Authorizing and Directing Banks and Financial Institutions to Honor and Process Checks and Transfers; (C) Extending the Deadline for Debtors to Comply with the Requirements of Section 345(b) of the Bankruptcy Code; and (D) Authorizing Debtors to Use Existing Bank Accounts and Existing Forms [Dkt. No. 8];
- iii. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Debtors to (A) Pay Prepetition Wages, Salaries, Reimbursable Expenses, and Other Obligations on Account of Compensation and Benefits Programs and (B) Continue Compensation and Benefits Programs, and (II) Granting Related Relief [Dkt. No. 9];
- iv. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC For Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Approving Proposed Form of Adequate Assurance of Payment to Utility Providers, (II) Establishing Procedures for Determining Adequate Assurance of Payment for Future Utility Services, (III) Prohibiting Utility Providers From Alerting, Refusing, or Discontinuing Utility Service, and (IV) Granting Related Relief [Dkt. No. 10];
- v. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Debtors to (A) Continue Their Insurance Programs and (B) Pay All Obligations With Respect Thereto, and (III) Granting Related Relief. [Dkt. No. 11];
- vi. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Debtors to Pay Certain Prepetition Tax Obligations, and (II) Granting Related Relief [Dkt. No. 12]; and

- vii. Emergency Motion filed by Debtor The Paper Store, LLC For Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Debtors to (A) Continue Customer Programs in the Ordinary Course of Business, and (B) Pay Prepetition Obligations Related Thereto, and (II) Granting Related Relief [Dkt. No. 13].


(collectively, the “Scheduled Motions”).

The Debtors shall provide notice by telephone, e-mail, or fax of the Hearing to (a) the U.S. Trustee; (b) the holders of the 25 largest unsecured claims against the Debtors on a consolidated basis; (c) counsel to the prepetition secured lenders; (d) taxing authorities; (e) the United States Attorney’s Office for the District of Massachusetts; and (f) any party which has filed a request for service of pleadings, and shall file a certificate of service with the Court regarding the same.
