PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, as set forth in the *Official Form 309F2 Notice of Commencement* [Docket No. 45] (the “Notice of Commencement”), pursuant to Rule 3003-1(a)(1) of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of New Jersey (the “Local Rules”), the deadline by which each person or entity (including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, corporations, joint ventures, and trusts), *other than governmental units*, must file a proof of claim (each, a “Proof of Claim”) based on any asserted

claims, as defined by section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code, against the Debtors that **arose prior to the Petition Date** (the “General Bar Date”) is **March 1, 2022**.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, as also set forth in the Notice of Commencement, pursuant to Rule 3003-1(a)(2) of the Local Rules, the deadline by which any governmental unit (as such term is defined in section 101(27) of the Bankruptcy Code) must file Proofs of Claim based on any asserted claims against the Debtors **that arose prior to the Petition Date** (the “Government Bar Date” and, together with the General Bar Date, the “Bar Dates”) is **June 21, 2022**.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code defines “claim” as a “(A) right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured, or unsecured; or (B) right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, secured, or unsecured.” 11 U.S.C. § 101(5).

PROOFS OF CLAIM WILL BE DEEMED TIMELY FILED ONLY IF ACTUALLY RECEIVED BY THE CLAIMS AGENT OR THE CLERK’S OFFICE ON OR BEFORE THE APPLICABLE BAR DATE. PROOFS OF CLAIM MAY NOT BE DELIVERED BY FACSIMILE, TELECOPY, OR EMAIL.

WHAT TO FILE:

The Debtors are enclosing with this notice a proof of claim form (the “Proof of Claim Form”) for asserting prepetition claims against the Debtors in the Chapter 11 Cases along with the Official Form 410 Instructions for Proof of Claim (the “Official Instructions”). Please refer to the Official Instructions in completing the Proof of Claim Form.

Holders of all claims must use the Proof of Claim Form. Additional copies of the Proof of Claim Form and the Official Instructions may be obtained from the website of the court-approved claims agent, Donlin, Recano & Company, Inc. (the “Claims Agent”): <https://www.donlinrecano.com/Clients/atl/Static/POC>. Proof of Claim Forms and the Official Instructions may also be obtained from the Court’s website: www.deb.uscourts.gov.

THE DEBTORS' SCHEDULES AND ACCESS THERETO:

You may be listed as the holder of a claim against the Debtors in the Debtors' Schedules of Assets and Liabilities (the "Schedules"). If your claim is included in the Schedules, your claim will be allowed in the amount scheduled unless: (i) your claim is designated as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated; (ii) you file a Proof of Claim in a different amount; or (iii) you receive another notice. If your claim is not scheduled or if your claim is designated as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated, you must file a Proof of Claim or you might not be paid on your claim and you might be unable to vote on a chapter 11 plan of the Debtors. You may file a Proof of Claim even if your claim is scheduled.

Electronic copies of the Schedules may be may be viewed free of charge at the Debtors' Claims Agent's website at www.donlinrecano.com/tenfour. Additionally, electronic copies of the Schedules may be examined by interested parties on the electronic docket of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey (the "Court") for the Chapter 11 Cases, which is available at www.njb.uscourts.gov (a PACER login and password are required and can be obtained through the PACER Service Center at <http://www.pacer.psc.uscourts.gov>). Copies of the Schedules may also be examined by interested parties between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (Eastern Time) at the office of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey, MLK Jr Federal Building, 50 Walnut Street, Newark, NJ 07102.
