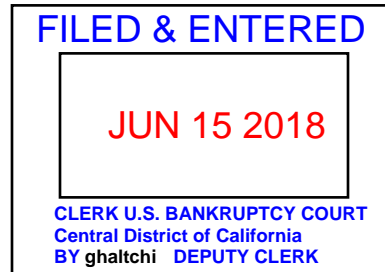

ORDER ON MOTION  
TO EXTEND TIME

1 On the above captioned date and time, the Court considered the *Motion for: (1) Extension*  
2 *of Time in which to Assume or Reject Unexpired Leases of Nonresidential Real Property through*  
3 *September 14, 2018; and (2) Extension of Term of Store Closing Sales Through September 14,*  
4 *2018* [Docket No. 172] (the “Motion”) filed on May 18, 2018 by Debtor and Debtor in Possession  
5 B&B Liquidating, LLC, f/k/a B&B Bachrach, LLC, (the “Debtor”) in which the Debtor seeks: (1)  
6 an extension of time to assume or reject unexpired leases of nonresidential real property pursuant  
7 to section 365(d)(4)(B) of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”); and (2) a  
8 corresponding extension of the previously approved inventory liquidation, “store closing” or  
9 similar themed sales (the “Store Closing Sales”) pursuant to Rule 9006(b) of the Federal Rules of  
10 Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules” and each a “Bankruptcy Rule”).

11 Based upon the Court’s review of the Motion, the *Declaration of Brian Lipman*  
12 accompanying the Motion, and the evidentiary record; it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction  
13 over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; it appearing that due and adequate notice  
14 of the Motion having been given under the circumstances; no objections having been filed; and  
15 after due deliberation and good cause appearing therefor,

16 IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 17 1. The Motion is granted.
- 18 2. The Debtor’s deadline to assume or reject unexpired leases of  
19 nonresidential real property set forth in section 364(b)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code is  
20 extended through and including September 14, 2018;

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3. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9006(b), the term of the Store Closing Sales previously authorized on a final basis by the Court by order entered on April 6, 2018 [Docket No. 115], the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, is extended through and including September 14, 2018.
