- For Do to be ordered to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$267,889.64, plus prejudgment interest thereon of \$50,899.12 (or a total of \$318,788.76). The SEC further seeks an order holding Nguyen jointly and severally liable for Do's disgorgement and prejudgment interest amounts (\$318,788.76).
