**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' EMERGENCY MOTION
TO COMPEL WINDSTREAM TO COMPLY WITH UTILITY ORDERS**

Upon the motion (the "**Motion**")² of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "**Debtors**"), for entry of an order compelling the Windstream to reinstate the Debtors' utilities services; and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors and other parties in interest and sufficient notice of the Motion having been given under the circumstances; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that venue of this proceeding and this Motion are properly in this district under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and after due deliberation and cause appearing therefore; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion have established just cause for the relief requested herein;
