**NOTICE REGARDING DECEMBER 10, 2018 TELEPHONIC HEARING
REGARDING WINDSTREAM'S COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER GRANTING
EMERGENCY EX PARTE RELIEF TO COMPEL WINDSTREAM
TO COMPLY WITH UTILITY ORDERS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 7, 2018, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina (the "**Court**") entered the *Order Granting Emergency Ex Parte Relief to Compel Windstream to Comply with Utility Orders and Scheduling Hearing to Review Compliance* [Dkt. 174] in the above-captioned bankruptcy case (the "**Order**").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to the Order, the Court scheduled a telephonic hearing for **Monday, December 10, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. Eastern Time** to review Windstream's compliance with the Order and the prior Utility Orders (the "**Hearing**").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that due to a scheduling conflict the Honorable David R. Duncan, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of South Carolina, will preside over the Hearing in place of the Honorable Helen E. Burris. Until further notice, all communication regarding the Order or the Hearing should be made with Judge Duncan's chambers.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the instructions for participating in the Hearing contained in the paragraph 3 of the Order have been updated in accordance with this Notice. Information necessary to participate in the Hearing may be obtained by calling **803-765-5436** and consulting with Dawn Hardesty (Judge Duncan's law clerk) or other members of the Court's staff between the hours of **9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Eastern Time on Monday, December 10, 2018**. Should Windstream comply with the Order to the Debtors' satisfaction prior to the scheduled Hearing, the Debtors may report compliance to the Court and no Hearing will be held.
