**NOTICE CANCELLING DECEMBER 10, 2018 TELEPHONIC HEARING  
REGARDING WINDSTREAM'S COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER GRANTING  
EMERGENCY EX PARTE RELIEF TO COMPEL WINDSTREAM TO COMPLY WITH  
UTILITY ORDERS**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on December 7, 2018, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina (the "**Court**") entered the *Order Granting Emergency Ex Parte Relief to Compel Windstream to Comply with Utility Orders and Scheduling Hearing to Review Compliance* [Dkt. 174] in the above-captioned bankruptcy case (the "**Order**"). Pursuant to the Order, the Court scheduled a telephonic hearing for Monday, December 10, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. Eastern Time to review Windstream's compliance with the Order and the prior Utility Orders (the "**Hearing**").

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that paragraph 3 of the Order provides, "Should Windstream comply [with the Order and the Utility Orders] to Debtors' satisfaction prior to the scheduled hearing, Debtors may report compliance to the Court and no hearing will be held."

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Order, the Debtors hereby report to the Court that, after failing to fully comply with the Order on December 7-9, Windstream has fully restored services to the Debtors as of the morning of December 10, 2018, and the **Hearing is cancelled**.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the Debtors reserve all rights to pursue damages against Windstream as a result of Windstream's improper termination of the Debtors' utility services and Windstream's failure to comply with the Order and immediately restore services.
