**DECLARATION OF B. KEITH POSTON IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR AUTHORIZATION TO RETAIN AND EMPLOY NELSON MULLINS RILEY & SCARBOROUGH, LLP, AS BANKRUPTCY CO-COUNSEL**  
**EFFECTIVE NUNC PRO TUNC TO NOVEMBER 30, 2018**

I, B. Keith Poston, Esquire, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

1. I am a partner in the firm of Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP, (“**Nelson Mullins**” or the “**Firm**”),<sup>1</sup> 1320 Main Street, Columbia, SC 29201. I am certified by the Supreme Court of South Carolina as a specialist in the areas of Bankruptcy/Debtor-Creditor law and am a partner in the Bankruptcy & Financial Restructuring Practice Group at Nelson Mullins.

2. I am admitted to practice, and a member in good standing of the bar of the State of South Carolina, the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit.

3. I am authorized to make this declaration (the “**Declaration**”) in support of the application of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Café Holdings Corp., *et al.* (the “**Committee**”) seeking approval to retain and employ Nelson Mullins as co-counsel to the Committee.

4. On November 28, 2018, pursuant to section 1102 of the Bankruptcy Code, the United States Trustee appointed five creditors to serve on the Committee in connection with these chapter 11 cases. The members of the Committee are: B&T Sand Co., Inc., Carolina Childcare Properties, LLC, Koury Corporation, Store Master Funding V, LLC, and Thrift Brothers, Inc.

5. On November 30, 2018 (the "**Retention Date**"), the Committee, in connection with the exercise of its powers and the performance of the duties conferred upon it pursuant to section 1103 of the Bankruptcy Code, selected Nelson Mullins as its co-counsel and local counsel, subject to approval of this Court.

6. The Committee has also selected and is, by separate application, seeking to employ Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones ("**PSZ&J**") to serve as co-counsel during these cases. Although NMRS and PSZ&J will work closely together in providing services to the Committee, PSZ&J and NMRS will not perform duplicative services for the Committee. NMRS has been, and will continue to consult, with the Committee and PSZ&J throughout the pendency of these cases on the division of responsibilities and the efficient coordination of efforts to best serve the Committee. For example, NMRS will be primarily, although not necessarily exclusively, responsible for retention application matters, communications with the U.S. Trustee and the Court, and appearing at the Debtors' 341 meeting and omnibus hearings. In addition, Nelson Mullins, as local counsel, will also review all matters filed before the Court for compliance with the SC LBR and as required by SC LBR 2090-1.

7. PSZ&J is primarily handling the negotiations with the Debtors' DIP Lender on the DIP Financing motion and any global case implications arising therefrom as the DIP Lender is also the stalking horse bidder. Nelson Mullins is primarily responsible for

responding to the Debtors' motion to sell substantially all assets and the bid procedures related thereto. Both PSZ&J and NMRS will have separate areas of responsibility that reflect their respective roles and that recognize, where appropriate, their respective proximities to the Debtors, the Court, and significant parties in interest in these cases.

**CONNECTIONS WITH THE DEBTORS, THEIR ESTATES, PROFESSIONALS, AND THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE**

8. Based on the conflicts search conducted to date and as described herein, to the best of my knowledge, neither I, the Firm, nor any partner, counsel or associate thereof, insofar as I have been able to ascertain, has any connection with the Debtors, their creditors or any other parties-in-interest, or their respective attorneys and accountants, nor with the United States Trustee or any person employed in the Office of the United States Trustee (the "**U.S. Trustee**"), except as disclosed or as otherwise described herein.

9. I am not related, and to the best of my knowledge, no attorney at the Firm is related, to any United States Bankruptcy Judge in this District or to the United States Trustee for such district or any employee thereof<sup>2</sup>. The undersigned and others in Nelson Mullins have had social interactions with the United States Bankruptcy Judges in this District and with the Office of the United States Trustee, mostly in conjunction with bar or court activities.

10. The undersigned and perhaps others in Nelson Mullins have had limited social, limited business, and limited bar function contacts with various attorneys that have appeared to date representing the Debtors, various creditors, and other parties in interest. Examples of such contacts would be serving on local rules committees, attendance at social functions together, and engaging other counsel for limited purposes. To the best of the knowledge of the undersigned,

none of the present attorneys appearing to date for parties in interest have been engaged by NMRS for business purposes, and no member of NMRS is presently engaged by any of the aforesaid attorneys for parties in interest.

11. To the best of my knowledge and information, Nelson Mullins neither holds nor represents any interest adverse to the Committee, the Debtors, their creditors or other parties in interest or their respective attorneys in these chapter 11 cases.

12. Debtor Café Enterprises, Inc. has scheduled Nelson Mullins in its Schedule F as holding a pre-petition claim in the amount of \$4,129.54, arising from a trademark matter Nelson Mullins performed for that Debtor in 2016. However, Nelson Mullins had previously written off that receivable and waives any claim related thereto. Nelson Mullins holds no pre-petition claims against any of the Debtors.

13. On November 8, 2018 and prior to the Debtors' petition date, the Debtors had telephone conversations with two of Nelson Mullins' partners regarding the Debtors' potential bankruptcy filings and sought to retain Nelson Mullins as their bankruptcy counsel. On November 9, 2018, Nelson Mullins advised the Debtors that it could not represent them in these chapter 11 cases. However, out of an abundance of caution, an ethical wall has been placed around the attorneys who spoke with the Debtors prior to the Petition Date and none of those attorneys will be engaged in this matter. Further, Nelson Mullins did not receive a payment, a retainer, or any form of compensation from the Debtors arising from its discussions with the Debtors on November 8 and November 9, 2018.

14. No confidential information has been shared with the undersigned or any other Nelson Mullins attorneys representing the Committee.

15. Based upon the information available to me, I believe that Nelson Mullins is a “disinterested person” within the meaning of section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code.

16. Nelson Mullins has made the following investigation of its connections prior to submitting this Declaration. Nelson Mullins has undertaken a full and thorough review of its computer database, which contains the names of clients and other parties in interest in particular matters. A copy of the conflict search list is attached hereto as **Schedule 1**. Except as otherwise set forth herein, Nelson Mullins has no connection (as such term is used in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a)) with the Debtors, their creditors, any other party in interest, the U.S. Trustee, or any person employed by the U.S. Trustee. Provided, however, that certain attorneys at Nelson Mullins serve as panel trustees in other districts and have from time to time served as chapter 11 and plan trustees in unrelated matters.

17. Nelson Mullins and certain of its partners, counsel and associates may have in the past represented, may currently represent and in the future likely will represent parties-in-interest to the Debtors in connection with matters unrelated to the Debtors and these chapter 11 cases (except as described below). Nelson Mullins has searched its electronic database for any connection it may have to the entities listed below. The information listed herein may have changed without our knowledge and may change during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. Nelson Mullins will update this Declaration when necessary and when it becomes aware of material information requiring an amendment to this Declaration.

18. While the results of these searches revealed no conflict of interest with regard to Nelson Mullins anticipated representation of the Committee, certain connections to potential parties-in-interest, in matters unrelated to this case, were revealed. Out of an abundance of

caution and in the interest of full candor to the Court, those connections are disclosed in

**Schedule 2**, with additional information as to certain parties-in-interest being provided below:

- (a) Café Enterprises, Inc. Nelson Mullins previously provided corporate, real estate, labor and employment, intellectual property, and general litigation to this Debtor. Regarding Corporate matters, Nelson Mullins assisted with Café Enterprises' employee welfare plan, and provided advice on VIP Fundraising and Marketing. Regarding real estate transactions, Nelson Mullins assisted with a building acquisition in 1993, and represented Café Enterprises in the following lease transactions: lease with James B. Rogers and Louis Manios, lease with Trinity Johnson City, LLC, lease with Koury Corporation, lease with Woodruff Road PlazaGreen and also the assignment of that lease to Tavern 24, the ground lease in Gastonia, the purchase of 3.17 acres in Greenwood, SC, the purchase of 1.371 acres in Asheville, the purchase of 2.705 acres on Highway 290, and a lease with RCC Shoppes at Market West, LLC. Regarding labor and employment, Nelson Mullins drafted general employee contract forms (no specific employee) and represented Café Enterprises in a matter designated as *Brown v. Fatz Café* that concluded in 1992. Regarding general litigation matters, Nelson Mullins represented Fatz in the following cases: *Greens Enterprises v. Café Enterprises* (matter closed in 1999); *Joytime Distributors v. Café Enterprises* (matter closed in 1997); *Reynolds Brothers v. Café Enterprises* (matter closed in 2000); *Café Enterprises v. Fat Boyz* (matter closed in 2002); and litigation regarding fraudulent telephone listings (matter closed in 2012). Finally, Nelson Mullins did provide a local counsel opinion letter on behalf of Café Enterprises to Triangle Mezzanine Fund LLLP regarding the enforceability of the Second Lien Credit Facility. However, as Triangle Mezzanine Fund LLLP no longer holds this debt and as the debtors have represented that the Second Lien Credit Facility is "out-of-the-money" (and will thus be treated as a general unsecured creditor), the Committee is not in an adversarial position with this creditor. However, to the extent a dispute arises between the Debtors and/or the Committee regarding the Second Lien Credit Facility previously held by Triangle Mezzanine Fund LLLP, PSZ&J shall serve as conflicts counsel to handle such dispute. Nelson Mullins' last engagement was a trademark matter that concluded in June 2017. As previously discussed hereinabove, Café Enterprises, Inc. has scheduled Nelson Mullins in its

Schedule F as holding a pre-petition claim in the amount of \$4,129.54, arising from a trademark matter Nelson Mullins performed for that Debtor in 2016. However, Nelson Mullins had previously written off that receivable and waives any claim related thereto. Nelson Mullins holds no pre-petition claims against this Debtor or any of the Debtors. Nelson Mullins has no open matters with any of the Debtors, and will not be performing any work for the Debtors. Accordingly, Nelson Mullins has no conflict with this Debtor or any of the Debtors and can be adverse to them in all matters in these chapter 11 cases.

- (b) Benefit Street Partners. Nelson Mullins currently represents Benefit Street Partners in matters unrelated to these chapter 11 cases.
- (c) Madison Capital Funding LLC. Madison Capital Funding is affiliated with Nelson Mullins' client New York Life Insurance Company. Nelson Mullins has not represented Madison Capital Funding, LLC, but has active matters with New York Life Insurance Company unrelated to these chapter 11 cases.
- (d) Sysco Columbia, Sysco Corporation, Freshpoint, Inc. Nelson Mullins previously represented Sysco Columbia in litigation matters unrelated to these chapter 11 cases. Further, Sysco Corporation and Freshpoint, Inc. (as a subsidiary of Sysco Corporation) are former clients of Nelson Mullins, in matters unrelated to these chapter 11 cases.
- (e) Sysco Charlotte. Nelson Mullins previously represented Sysco Charlotte in bankruptcy matters that concluded in April 2014 and unrelated to these chapter 11.
- (f) Old Mill Stream, LLC. Nelson Mullins previously represented Old Mill Stream, LLC in corporate and real estate matters. However, Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in January 2012.
- (g) Gary Smith. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "Gary Smith" in real estate matters. Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in April 2008. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Gary Smith" identified as one of the Debtors' creditors, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.
- (h) Pedro Garcia. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "Pedro Barcelo Garcia" in a corporate matter.



Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in November 2015. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Pedro Garcia" identified as one of the Debtors' equity holders, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.

- (i) Bill Burton. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "William H. Burton, III" in a real estate matter. Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in July 2002. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Bill Burton" identified as one of the Debtors' equity holders, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.
- (j) Richie Cannon. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "Rich Cannon" in a corporate matter. Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in April 2012. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Richie Cannon" identified as one of the Debtors' equity holders, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.
- (k) Steve Corson. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "Stephen Corson" in an eminent domain matter. Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in November 2017. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Steve Corson" identified as one of the Debtors' equity holders, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.
- (l) Gerald Johnson. Nelson Mullins has previously represented an individual named "Dr. Gerald Johnson" in an estate planning matter. Nelson Mullins' last engagement concluded in June 2011. Further, it is unknown whether this individual is the same "Gerald Johnson" identified as one of the Debtors' equity holders, but Nelson Mullins makes this disclosure out of an abundance of caution.

19. None of the parties listed on Schedule 1 represent more than 2% of Nelson Mullins' annual revenues over the past 2 years.

20. With the exception of Debtor Café Enterprises, Inc., as of the date of execution of this Declaration, the Committee is not in an adversarial position with the entities described in paragraph 17 hereof and Nelson Mullins will not be taking any position adverse to such entities.

Further, as Benefit Street Partners is an “out-of-the-money” junior lienholder, the Committee is not in an adversarial position with it.

21. Committee member Thrift Brothers, Inc. (“**Thrift Brothers**”) is a former client of the Firm in matters unrelated to the Debtors or their estates. Additionally, beginning on approximately November 16, 2018, Nelson Mullins provided limited advice to Thrift Brothers in connection with these chapter 11 cases. Such advice was limited to a general summary of the treatment of leases in chapter 11 and assisting with completing Thrift Brother’s questionnaire relating to its interest to serve on the Committee. These facts were disclosed to the U.S. Trustee prior to formation of the Committee. Nelson Mullins received no compensation from Thrift Brothers in relation to this limited advice.

22. Pursuant to section 327(c) of the Bankruptcy Code, Nelson Mullins is not disqualified from acting as the Committee’s co-counsel merely because it represents creditors, equity security holders, and/or other parties in interest in unrelated matters.

23. To the best of my knowledge, no Nelson Mullins attorney is a shareholder or bondholder of the Debtors.

24. As part of its practice, Nelson Mullins appears in cases, proceedings and transactions involving many different attorneys, accountants, financial consultants and investment bankers, including other professionals representing the Committee or other parties in interest. In certain instances, such professionals may be the client of Nelson Mullins. All of the other cases, proceedings, and transactions in which Nelson Mullins is involved and professionals representing the Committee or other parties in interest are also involved are totally unrelated to the Debtors and these chapter 11 cases.

25. Nelson Mullins will periodically review its files during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases to ensure that no conflicts or other disqualifying circumstances exist or arise. If any new relevant facts or relationships are discovered or arise, Nelson Mullins will use reasonable efforts to identify any such further developments and will promptly supplement this Declaration as needed.

**SERVICES TO BE RENDERED**

26. Nelson Mullins will, in connection with these chapter 11 cases and subject to orders of this Court, provide the following services, among others, to the Committee:

- a. rendering legal advice regarding the Committee's organization, duties and powers in these cases;
- b. assisting the Committee in its investigation of the acts, conduct, assets, liabilities and financial condition of the Debtors and their operations and in the investigation of the extent, priority, and validity of liens and participating in and reviewing any proposed asset sales or dispositions, and any other matters relevant to these cases;
- c. attending meetings of the Committee and meetings with the Debtors and secured creditors, and their attorneys and other professionals, and participating in negotiations with these parties, as requested by the Committee;
- d. taking all necessary action to protect and preserve the interests of the Committee, including possible prosecution of actions on its behalf and investigations concerning all litigation in which the Debtors or their creditors may be involved, including avoidance actions and claims against directors, officers, and any other party;

- e. assisting the Committee in the review, formulation, analysis, and negotiation of any plan(s) of reorganization or liquidation and accompanying disclosure statement(s) that may be filed;
- f. assisting the Committee in the review, analysis, and negotiation of any financing or funding agreements and cash collateral stipulations or proceedings;
- g. assisting the Committee with respect to communications with the general unsecured creditor body about significant matters in these cases;
- h. reviewing and analyzing claims filed against the Debtors' estates;
- i. representing the Committee in hearings before the Court, appellate courts, and other courts in which matters may be heard, and representing the interests of the Committee before those courts and before the United States Trustee;
- j. assisting the Committee in preparing all necessary motions, applications, responses, reports and other pleadings in connection with the administration of these cases;
- k. assisting, advising, and representing the Committee in any manner relevant to the Debtors' rights and obligations under leases or executory contracts; and
- l. providing such other legal assistance as the Committee may deem necessary and appropriate.

#### **PROFESSIONAL COMPENSATION**

27. The Committee understands that Nelson Mullins intends to seek compensation for professional services rendered in connection with the Debtors' cases, subject to the Court's approval, and in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, the fee guidelines established by the Executive Office for the

United States Trustees and the Court's Orders, plus seek reimbursement of actual, necessary expenses and other charges that Nelson Mullins incurs in connection with its representation of the Committee.

28. Nelson Mullins has proposed to charge the Committee for its legal services on an hourly basis in accordance with its ordinary and customary rates, which are in effect on the date the services are rendered. The hourly rates are subject to periodic adjustment to reflect economic and other conditions and are consistent with the rates charged to other clients. At the current time, Nelson Mullins' hourly rates for the professionals expected to be involved in the Debtors' cases range as follows:

Partners	\$450-\$535
Associates	\$300-\$335
Paralegals	\$160-\$295

These rates are set at a level designed to compensate the Firm fairly for the work of its professionals and to cover fixed and routine overhead expenses. These hourly rates are subject to periodic adjustments to reflect economic and other conditions. Subject to approval by the Court, Nelson Mullins expects that the following attorneys will be primarily responsible for representing the Committee in this matter: Frank B. B. Knowlton (Partner); Shane G. Ramsey (Partner); B. Keith Poston (Partner); Graham S. Mitchell (Associate) and John T. Baxter (Associate). These attorneys' current hourly rates are \$535, \$565, \$450, \$300, and \$335, respectively.

29. The Committee has also agreed that Nelson Mullins will be reimbursed from the Debtors' estates, subject to the Court's approval, for all actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the Firm on the Committee's behalf, such as telephone and telecopier toll and other charges,

express mail charges, special or hand delivery charges, photocopying charges, travel expenses, computerized research, transcription costs, as well as non-ordinary overhead expenses.

30. The Committee understands that Nelson Mullins will charge the estates for its fees and expenses in a manner and at rates consistent with charges made generally to the Firm's other clients and all requests for reimbursement of expenses will be consistent with guidelines established by the Bankruptcy Court and the Executive Office for United States Trustees.

31. No promises have been received by Nelson Mullins nor by any partner, counsel or associate thereof as to compensation in connection with these Chapter 11 Cases other than in accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code. Nelson Mullins has no agreement with any other entity to share with such entity any compensation received by Nelson Mullins in connection with the Chapter 11 Cases.

32. Nelson Mullins further states pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016(b) that it has not shared, nor agreed to share (a) any compensation it has received or may receive with another party or person, other than with the partners, counsel and associates of Nelson Mullins, or (b) any compensation another person or party has received or may receive.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
