**ORDER GRANTING FINAL APPLICATION OF NELSON MULLINS RILEY &
SCARBOROUGH LLP FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION AND
REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR SERVICES RENDERED AS CO-COUNSEL
FOR THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR THE
PERIOD FROM NOVEMBER 30, 2018 THROUGH AND INCLUDING APRIL 15, 2019**

Upon consideration of the *Final Application of Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Services Rendered as Co-Counsel for The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for the Period from November 30, 2018 Through and Including April 15, 2019* (“Application”), the Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Application pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); (iii) the fees and expenses requested are reasonable, necessary, and beneficial to the Debtors’ estates and should be allowed; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Application and hearing thereon has been given, no objection to the Application have been filed, and no other or further notice is required; and (v) good and sufficient cause exists for granting the relief herein, after due deliberation upon the Application and all relevant proceedings before the Court in connection with the Application.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP shall be allowed final compensation of fees in the amount of \$81,695.00 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$2,097.42 for

services rendered on behalf of the Committee for the period of November 30, 2018 Through and Including April 15, 2019.

2. The Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP all unpaid fees and expenses allowed pursuant to this Order.

3. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
