**Proceedings:** VIDEO CONFERENCE ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY AN ORDER OF CIVIL CONTEMPT SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED [37]

Cause is called for hearing and counsel and the Pro Se defendants make their appearances via video conference. The Court orally issues his tentative ruling. Matter is argued.

The Court finds Justin King in contempt for making certain false representations to Naomi Hazen as stated on the record. With respect to the contempt found, the Court orders that within 10 days the Receiver shall post to their website the contempt pleadings in this matter, the transcript of this hearing and the minute order of this hearing. The Receiver shall begin posting the pleadings prior to receiving the transcript and minute order.

All other relief denied.
