This matter came before the Court upon the Stipulation Regarding Preliminary Injunction of plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") and Defendants Elevate Investments LLC and Justin Robert King, and Relief Defendant Shannon Leigh King.

The Court, having considered the Stipulation, and the other evidence and argument presented to the Court, orders as follows:

## IT IS ORDERED:

The hearing for the defendants to show cause, if there be any, why a preliminary injunction should not be granted (the "PI Hearing"), which was originally scheduled for January 11, 2021 at 9:00 a.m., is adjourned to January 19, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Any opposition papers in connection with the PI Hearing must be served and filed by defendants on or before January 12, 2021 at noon. Any reply papers must be served and filed by the SEC on or before January 14, 2021 at noon.

The Temporary Restraining Order, Order to Show Cause Why a 1. Preliminary Injunction Should Not Be Granted, and Orders (1) Freezing Assets; (2) Requiring Accountings; (3) Prohibiting the Destruction of Documents; and (4) Appointing a Receiver dated December 28, 2021 will be extended until, and will expire upon, the conclusion of the PI Hearing, on January 19, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.
