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**ORDER GRANTING THE LIQUIDATING TRUST'S EIGHTEENTH OMNIBUS  
MOTION OBJECTING TO AND RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN RECLAMATION  
AND 503(B)(9) CLAIMS OF CLAIMANTS THAT FAILED TO PARTICIPATE IN  
MEDIATION**

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This matter is before the Court on the Gander Mountain Liquidating Trust ("Trust") and META Advisors LLC, in its capacity as the liquidating trustee ("Liquidating Trustee") of the Trust's Eighteenth Omnibus Motion Objecting to Certain Reclamation and 503(b)(9) Claims of Claimants That Failed to Participate in Mediation (the "Motion"). Based on the Motion and the documents of record herein,

**IT IS ORDERED:**

1. The Motion is granted.
2. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3007(c), the Trust is authorized to include the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants in an omnibus objection.
3. The following Reclamation Claims and 503(b)(9) Claims asserted by the following claimants ("Claims of Non-Participating Claimants") are reclassified as non-administrative, non-priority, general unsecured claims in the following amounts:

4. For the avoidance of doubt, the Claims of the Non-Participating Claimants will not have administrative or priority status. The Trust and the Liquidating Trustee expressly reserve the rights to: (i) file subsequent objections to any of the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants on any ground (substantive or non-substantive); (ii) amend, modify or supplement the Motion, including, without limitation, filing objections to further amended or newly filed claims; (iii) seek to expunge or reduce any of the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants to the extent all or a portion of such claim has been paid; and (iv) settle any of the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants for less than the asserted amount. Additionally, should the grounds of objection stated in the Motion be overruled, the Liquidating Trustee’s rights to object to the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants on any other grounds are preserved.

5. To the extent the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants are also the subject of a separate claim objection, or become subject to a separate claim objection, on other grounds, whether by separate motion or through an adversary proceeding, this Order does not affect, eliminate, or determine those separate objections.

6. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in the Motion or this Order impacts in any way the Liquidating Trustee’s pending objection to any claim under section 502(d) of the Bankruptcy Code included in any complaint filed pursuant to section 5 of the Bankruptcy Code.

7. The objection to each of the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants, as addressed in the Motion and as set forth in the chart above, constitutes a separate contested matter as

contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. This Order shall be deemed a separate order with respect to each of the Claims of Non-Participating Claimants that is the subject of the Motion. Any stay of this Order pending appeal by any claimants whose claims are subject to this Order shall only apply to the contested matter that involves such claimant and shall not act to stay the applicability and/or finality of this Order with respect to any other contested matters addressed in the Motion and this Order.

8. The Trust and the Liquidating Trustee are authorized to take any and all actions that are necessary and appropriate to give effect to this Order.

9. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over all matters arising from or related to the interpretation and implementation of this Order.
