**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on **August 30, 2021** (the “Petition Date”), The Prospect-Woodward Home, the above-captioned debtor and debtor in possession (the “Debtor”), filed a voluntary petition commencing a case (the “Chapter 11 Case”) for relief under chapter 11 of the title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”) in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (the “Bankruptcy Court”).

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that at a hearing on September 2, 2021 (the “First Day Hearing”), the Bankruptcy Court granted certain first day relief on an interim basis.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that in connection with the filing of this Chapter 11 Case, the Debtor has filed the following motions (collectively, the “First Day Pleadings”):

1. *Emergency Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for Entry of Interim and Final Orders Authorizing (I) Payment of Certain Employee Compensation and Benefits and (II) Maintenance and continuation of Such Benefits and Other Employee related Programs* [Docket No. 12];
2. *Emergency Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for Entry of an Order Determining that Appointment of a Patient Care Ombudsman is Not Required in this Case* [Docket No. 14];
3. *Emergency Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Continuation of, and Payment of Prepetition Obligations Incurred in the Ordinary Course of Business in Connection with, Various Insurance Policies, (II) Authorizing banks to Honor and Process checks and Electronic Transfer Requests related Thereto, and (III) Preventing Insurance Companies from Giving any Notice of termination or Otherwise Modifying any Insurance Policy Without Obtaining Relief from the Automatic Stay* [Docket No. 17];
4. *Emergency Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Continued Use of Existing Cash Management System,*

5. *Amended Emergency Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Use of Cash Collateral, (II) Granting Adequate Protection, (III) Modifying the Automatic Stay, (IV) Setting a Final Hearing, and (V) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 25]; and
6. *Ex Parte Motion of Debtor for Entry of an Order (I) Prohibiting Utility Providers from Altering, Refusing, or Discontinuing Service and (II) Approving the Debtor's Proposed Adequate Assurance of Payment for Postpetition Services* [Docket No. 97].

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that a hearing to consider the First Day Pleadings on a final basis has been scheduled for **September 24, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. (prevailing Eastern Time)** before the Honorable Bruce A. Harwood at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire, 55 Pleasant Street, Suite 2300, Concord, New Hampshire 03301 (the "Hearing"). Pursuant to the Court's *Fourteenth General Order Regarding Court Operations Under the Exigent Circumstances Created by COVID-19*, the Hearing will be conducted by videoconference. Instructions for participation at the Hearing will be distributed prior to the Hearing.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that objections to the Pleadings must be filed no later than **September 17, 2021** with the with the Clerk, United States Bankruptcy Court, Warren B. Rudman U.S. Courthouse, 55 Pleasant Street, Room 200, Concord, New Hampshire 03301, with a copy to the undersigned at the address set forth below, to the United States Trustee, the chapter 11 trustee, if applicable, and to all other interested parties, and a certificate of such action must be filed with the clerk. If you file an objection, you must also appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above.
