**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION OF ROSEMONT SUMMIT OPERATING LLC
FOR ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM**

On _____, 2019, this Court heard the *Application of Rosemont Summit Operating LLC for Allowance and Payment of Administrative Claim*, Docket No. __, (the “Application”) filed by Rosemont Summit Operating LLC (“Rosemont”).

Having reviewed the Application, the Court finds this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 503(b) and 507(a)(1) and that notice of the Application was proper under the United States Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and

the local rules and orders of the Court. The Court, having read and considered the Application, further finds that the relief requested in the Application is appropriate and should be granted. It is therefor

ORDERED that the Application is GRANTED as set forth below.

IT IS ORDERED Rosemont is entitled to an administrative claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 503(b) and 507(a)(1) in the amount of \$98,318.86.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Debtors are to make immediate payment to Rosemont on account of Rosemont's administrative expense claim now and as the amount continues to accrue as funds become available.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is without prejudice to any or further relief which Rosemont may seek consistent with the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce this Order.
