The undersigned hereby certifies that, as of the date hereof, she has received no answer, objection or other responsive pleading to the First Monthly Application of Sidley Austin LLP (“Sidley”) for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from January 22, 2019 to and Including February 28, 2019 [Docket No. 175] (the “Application”), filed on March 25, 2019. The undersigned further certifies that she has reviewed the Court’s docket in these cases and no answer, objection or other responsive pleading to the Application appears thereon. Pursuant to the Notice of Fee Application, objections to the Application were to be filed and served no later than April 15, 2019 (the “Objection Deadline”).

Prior to the Objection Deadline, Sidley received informal comments to the Application from the Office of the United States Trustee (“UST”). Following discussions with the UST, Sidley agreed to reduce its Application by \$5,164.50 in fees and \$63.61 in expenses. In

accordance with the Court's February 21, 2019 Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals and Official Committee Members [Docket No. 91], the Debtors are authorized to pay Sidley 80% of the fees requested in the Application, less the reduction, for a total of \$494,907.60 and 100% of the expenses requested in the Application, less the reduction, for a total of \$4,666.32.
