PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on April 24, 2019, the **Combined² Second Monthly Application of James L. Patton, Jr., as the Legal Representative for Future Asbestos Claimants and Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP as Counsel to the Legal Representative for Future Asbestos Claimants for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period From March 1, 2019 Through March 31, 2019** (the "Application") has been filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware.
