**ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE OF MOTION OF VIACOM INTERNATIONAL INC.  
PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 362(d) AND 553 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE FOR

Upon the motion (the “Motion to Shorten”),<sup>2</sup> of Viacom International Inc. pursuant to sections 102(1) and 105 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 9006 and Local Rule 9006-1(e), requesting an order shortening notice to allow the *Motion of Viacom International Inc. Pursuant to Sections 362(d) and 553 of the Bankruptcy Code for Relief from the Stay to Effectuate Setoff* (the “Motion for Relief from Stay”) to be considered at the hearing scheduled for November 9, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. (ET); and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion to Shorten and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion to Shorten and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1409(a); and due and proper notice of the Motion to Shorten having been provided to the parties listed therein and no adverse interest being affected; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,
