NOTICE OF HEARING ON MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY TO PERMIT ISSUANCE OF NOTICE TERMINATING AGREEMENT AT END OF TERM

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that on March 27, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. [New York Time] or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, a hearing will be held before the Honorable James M. Peck, United States Bankruptcy Judge, at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the “Bankruptcy Court”), Alexander Hamilton Custom House, Courtroom 601, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004, to consider The Economist Newspaper, N.A., Inc.’s (the “Movant”) motion for relief from the automatic stay to permit the issuance of a notice terminating a certain printing agreement effective as of the expiration of the initial term of the printing agreement (the “Motion”).
