BY THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS**

1. I am an attorney at law admitted to practice in the State of New York and in the United States District Courts for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York. I am a member of the firm of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP (“Akin Gump”), which firm maintains offices at 590 Madison Avenue, New York, New York 10022.

2. I am familiar with the matters set forth herein and make this declaration (the “Declaration”) in connection with Akin Gump’s role as counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Quebecor World (USA) Inc., et al. (the “Committee”). The purpose of this Declaration is to fulfill Akin Gump’s continuing obligation to update its disclosures as set forth in the Application of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Quebecor World

(USA) Inc., et al. to Retain and Employ Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP as Counsel, nunc pro tunc to January 31, 2008, which this Court approved pursuant to an order entered on February 21, 2008.

3. Akin Gump has been retained to represent Flint Group North America Corporation (“Flint”) in connection with a personal injury action commenced by an employee of Debtor Quebecor World Dallas against Flint in the County Court of Dallas, Texas, styled *Mario Palos v. Flint Group North America Corporation CC-08-02158-A* (the “Action”). Akin Gump’s representation of Flint in connection with the Action is wholly unrelated to its representation of the Committee or the Debtors’ chapter 11 bankruptcy proceedings. Out of an abundance of caution, however, Akin Gump has established an ethical wall between the attorneys and staff associated with the representation of the Committee and the representation of Flint, respectively.
