AFFIDAVIT OF REBECCA MENDEZ IN SUPPORT OF MARLIN LEASING CORPORATION'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY

I, Rebecca Mendez, do hereby declare:

1. I am a Bankruptcy Paralegal of Marlin Leasing Corporation ("Marlin"), and as such I am fully familiar with the facts and circumstances of this action. I have in my possession all papers and documents in connection therewith. I make this affidavit based upon my personal knowledge, except as to matters stated herein on my information and belief, and as to those matters, I believe my information to be true and correct. If called as a witness, I could and would competently testify to the matters contained herein.

2. As a Bankruptcy Paralegal, I oversee the monitoring of accounts where: (a) the borrower is in default under the terms of a lease or finance agreement; and (b) the borrower has filed a petition for relief under the Bankruptcy Code.

3. Based upon my review of documents under my supervision and control, I know of my own knowledge of the following facts contained herein.

4. On or about July 23, 2007, a mere six (6) months before the Debtor filed bankruptcy, the Debtor entered into an Equipment Lease Contract (the "Contract") with Marlin. A true and correct copy of the Contract is attached to Marlin's Motion for Relief.

5. Pursuant to the Contract, Debtor leased (2) Kirk-Rudy Tabber, S/N 0705-1534, 0705-1535 and (2) Independent Roller Register Table, SIN 711,712 (collectively the

"Equipment"). The Contract was for a term of 24 months and required monthly payments of \$2,173.91, to be made on the 20th day of each month.

6. Marlin filed a UCC-1 Financing Statement with the Delaware Secretary of State, thereby perfecting a security interest in the Equipment. A true and correct copy of the UCC-1 Financing Statement is attached to Marlin's Motion for Relief.


7. The Debtor is currently 4 monthly contract payments in arrears (two pre-petition and two post petition) for a total of \$9,217.36 (inclusive of taxes). The total accelerated amount due on the Contract is currently \$49,629.44.

8. The Debtor is currently in possession of the Equipment, and upon information and belief, continues to use such Equipment in the operation of its business.

9. As a result of such usage, the value of the Equipment and Marlin's interest therein is depreciating.

10. Accordingly, Marlin respectfully requests that this Court Order the Debtor to provide Marlin with adequate protection, in the form of monthly payments or alternatively to grant Marlin relief from stay so that it may pursue recovery of the Equipment and begin to mitigate its damages.

11. I declare under the penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
