**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF S. RICHARD ORZY
IN CONNECTION WITH THE RETENTION OF BENNETT JONES LLP
BY THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS**

S. RICHARD ORZY, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am an attorney at law admitted to practise in the Province of Ontario in Canada. I am a member of the firm of Bennett Jones LLP ("Bennett Jones"), which firm maintains offices at Suite 3400, One First Canadian Place, Toronto, Ontario M5X 1A4, Canada. I am familiar with the matters set forth herein. By order dated April 17, 2008, Bennett Jones was retained to be Canadian counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Creditors' Committee") of Quebecor World (USA) Inc., *et al* (collectively, the "Debtors"). In connection with this representation, I make this supplemental declaration in regard to Bennett Jones' obligation to update its disclosures as set forth in the Application of the Official

Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Quebecor World (USA) Inc., *et al* to Retain and Employ Bennett Jones LLP as Canadian Counsel, Nunc Pro Tunc to March 4, 2008.

2. Bennett Jones was recently retained to be counsel to Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as Monitor of Progressive Moulded Products Limited and three related companies (collectively, "Progressive") in the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* (Canada) proceedings commenced by Progressive in Canada. The Progressive matter is wholly unrelated to the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases and the role of Ernst & Young Inc. as Monitor pursuant to the Progressive matter is wholly unrelated to the role of Ernst & Young Inc. as Monitor in the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* cases commenced by the Debtors. Each is a court officer in a proceeding in a different court in a different Province of Canada. Progressive operated in the automotive supply industry and is currently in liquidation.

I hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
