**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE FILING UNDER SEAL OF THE LIMITED
OBJECTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED
CREDITORS TO MOTION OF THE DEBTORS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 363
AND 365 FOR AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO MEMORANDUM OF
AGREEMENT AMENDING A PRINTING AGREEMENT WITH PARADE
PUBLICATIONS AND TO ASSUME THE PRINTING AGREEMENT AS AMENDED**

Upon consideration of the motion (the “Seal Motion”) of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “Committee”) of Quebecor World (USA) Inc., et al. (the “Debtors”) for entry of an order authorizing the Committee to file under seal its Limited Objection to the Motion of the Debtors Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 363 and 365 for Authority to Enter into Memorandum of Agreement Amending a Printing Agreement with Parade Publications and to Assume the Printing Agreement as Amended (the “Committee’s Limited Objection”); it is hereby

ORDERED that pursuant to section 107(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Rule 9018 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Committee’s Limited Objection and related documents, declarations, attachments, annexes and exhibits, if any, shall be sealed and all parties that receive copies of the unredacted Committee’s Limited Objection in connection with these cases shall not disclose and shall keep confidential the contents of the unredacted Committee’s Limited Objection and related documents, declarations, attachments, annexes and exhibits, except as necessary in connection with these proceedings; and it is further

ORDERED that unredacted copies of the Committee's Limited Objection shall be served upon counsel for the Debtors, counsel for the Ad Hoc Committee of Quebecor Noteholders, counsel for the Debtors' prepetition lenders, and the United States Trustee. A redacted version of the Committee's Limited Objection shall be served on all parties entitled to service of the Committee Objection.
