ALTERNATIVELY, (ii) DIRECTING PAYMENT OF ADEQUATE PROTECTION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT upon the annexed application (the "Application"),
People's Capital and Leasing Corp. ("People's"), by its attorneys, Moritt Hock Hamroff &
Horowitz LLP, will move before the Honorable James M. Peck, at the United States Bankruptcy
Court for the Southern District of New York Courtroom 601, One Bowling Green, New York,
New York 10004-1408, on September 18, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. (the "Hearing"), or as soon after as
counsel may be heard for an Order: (i) terminating, vacating or modifying the automatic stay
pursuant to Section 362(d) to permit People's to take possession of the 2000 and 2001 Collateral

(as those terms are defined in the Application) or, alternatively, (ii) directing payment of adequate protection pursuant to Section 361 of the Bankruptcy Code.
