**ORDER DIRECTING REORGANIZED DEBTORS TO FILE
MOTION TO ESTIMATE DISPUTED CLASS 3 CLAIMS
AND TO ESTABLISH DISTRIBUTION RESERVE FOR
DISPUTED CLASS 3 CLAIMS**

Upon the motion (the “Motion”)⁵ of Riverside Claims, LLC, dated December 16, 2010, by its counsel, Herrick, Feinstein LLP, for entry of an order compelling the above-captioned reorganized debtors (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”) to seek Court-approved estimation of the aggregate amount of Disputed Class 3 Claims which may ultimately be Allowed and to establish a Distribution Reserve for Disputed Class 3 Claims; and a hearing having been held before me on January 6, 2011 (the “Hearing”); and upon the representations of counsel at the Hearing; and it appearing that proper and sufficient notice of the relief requested in the Motion has been given; and it further appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is reasonable and proper; and sufficient cause appearing therefore and due consideration having been given; and any and all objections to the relief requested in the Motion having been withdrawn or overruled; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted as set forth herein; and it is further

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Reorganized Debtors are hereby directed to file, within fourteen (14) days of the date of entry of this Order, a motion, in accordance with Section 8.10 of the Plan, seeking to estimate the aggregate amount of Disputed Class 3 Claims which may ultimately be Allowed.

2. Within three (3) business days following the date on which Disputed Class 3 Claims are estimated, the Reorganized Debtors are hereby directed to establish a Distribution Reserve for Class 3 Disputed Claims in the estimated amount of such Claims.
