This firm represents CenterPoint Energy Services, Inc. ("CES") in connection with the above-referenced case.


On January 4, 2011, CES, by its counsel, Meyer, Suozzi, English & Klein, P.C. and the Law Firm Of Russell R. Johnson III, PLC, filed the *Motion by CenterPoint Energy Services, Inc. to Compel Immediate Payment of Section 503(b)(9) Claim* (the "Motion"). The hearing on the Motion had been set for January 26, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.

On January 18, 2011, Quebecor World (USA) Inc. and 52 of its domestic direct and indirect subsidiaries, as reorganized debtors (collectively, the "Debtors"), filed their *Twelfth Omnibus Application Seeking to Allow Permitted Settlements* (the "Application"). The Debtors will present the Application to the Court on January 28, 2011, at 12:00 noon. Upon the Court's entry of the proposed order submitted in connection with the Application (the "Proposed Order"), the issues raised in CES's Motion will be resolved. In addition, upon the entry of the Proposed Order, CES's Motion shall be deemed withdrawn with prejudice.
