**ORDER APPROVING THE REORGANIZED DEBTORS' TENTH OMNIBUS

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Motion is APPROVED.

Each of the Convenience Claims identified on Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is allowed in its entirety in the amount set forth on Exhibit B pursuant to section 502 of the Bankruptcy Code, and such claims shall be accorded Convenience Class treatment under the Plan.

4. The terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

5. The Reorganized Debtors and their Claims Agent are authorized to take all such actions as are necessary or appropriate to implement the terms of this Order.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
