**ORDER SUSTAINING REORGANIZED DEBTORS' FIFTY-NINTH OMNIBUS
OBJECTION TO CLAIMS (SEEKING TO EXPUNGE CERTAIN
CANADIAN CLAIMS)**

This matter coming before the Court on the Reorganized Debtors' Fifty-Ninth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Seeking to Expunge Certain Canadian Claims) (the "Objection")¹; it appearing that the relief requested in the Objection is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors' estates, their creditors and other parties in interest; the Court having found that (a) it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (c) venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, and (d) notice of the Objection was provided to all necessary and appropriate parties; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish grounds for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Objection is SUSTAINED.

¹ Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Objection.

2. Each of the claims identified on each of Exhibit B and Exhibit C incorporated herein by reference is expunged and disallowed for all purposes in these Chapter 11 Cases, all pursuant to section 502 of the Bankruptcy Code.

3. This Order shall have no res judicata, estoppel or other effect on the validity or allowance, or disallowance of the Filed Canadian Claims and Transferred Canadian Claims in the Canadian Proceeding, and each of the Reorganized Debtors, QWI, the Monitor, the holders of the Filed Canadian Claims and Transferred Canadian Claims and any other parties in interest, shall retain all of their respective rights, claims and defenses in the Canadian Proceeding in respect of the Filed Canadian Claims and the Transferred Canadian Claims.

4. The terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

5. The Reorganized Debtors and their Claims Agent are authorized to take all such actions as are necessary or appropriate to implement the terms of this Order.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
