TO THE HONORABLE CHRISTOPHER B. LATHAM, CHIEF UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE, THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE, AND PARTIES IN INTEREST:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT The Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego ("Debtor"), the debtor and debtor-in-possession in the above captioned bankruptcy case, has filed six motions seeking immediate relief as follows (collectively, the "First Day Motions"):

- 3. DEBTOR'S FIRST DAY MOTION FOR INTERIM AND FINAL ORDERS TO PROTECT CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION AND ESTABLISHING NOTICE PROCEDURES
- 4. DEBTOR'S FIRST DAY APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF DONLIN, RECANO & COMPANY, INC. AS CLAIMS AND NOTICING AGENT, AND (II) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF
- 5. DEBTOR'S FIRST DAY MOTION FOR INTERIM AND FINAL ORDERS TO CONTINUE INSURANCE PROGRAMS
- 6. DEBTOR'S FIRST DAY MOTION FOR INTERIM AND FINAL ORDERS (A) AUTHORIZING (1) CONTINUED USE OF CASH MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND RELATED ACCOUNTS, (2) MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING BUSINESS FORMS, AND (3) CONTINUED USE OF CURRENT INVESTMENT POLICY; (B) EXCUSING COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 345(B); AND (C) SCHEDULING A FINAL HEARING

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN interim hearings on the First Day Motions are <u>June 18</u>, <u>2024</u>, <u>at 2:00 p.m.</u> at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of California, before the Honorable Judge Christopher B. Latham, 325 West F Street, Courtroom 218 (Department 1), San Diego, California 92101 (the "Fist Day Hearings"), at which the Court will hear and consider approval of the First Day Motions. Interested parties that would like to appear telephonically must contact the courtroom deputy.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT THE FIRST DAY MOTIONS ARE FILED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES FOR FIRST DAY MOTIONS. The First Day Motions are supported by the *Declaration of Rodrigo Valdivia in Support of First Day Motions* (the "Valdivia Declaration") and the *Declaration of Shirley Pajanor in Support of First Day Motions* (the "Pajanor Declaration," and together with the Valdivia Declaration, the "First Day Declarations").

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Debtor also requests that the Court set final hearings for approval of any interim relief granted in the First Day Motions. You will be provided notice of the date of any further or final hearings on the First Day Motions at a later time.
