C. Computation of Damages

FCStone's damages consist of the following:

\$13,116.60: financing and cost of shipping silver sold and delivered by FCStone to JP Morgan Chase Bank for Republic Metals Corporation. Of this total, \$7,850 is the shipping cost FCStone paid to Loomis and \$6,116.50 is the charge for financing at 5.26% per diem.

\$141,642.60 for 106.71 ounces of gold and 765.941 ounces of silver FCStone delivered to RMC on October 4, 2018. The dollar amounts associated with these weights were determined using the LBMA auction prices, which is how the parties transacted in the ordinary course. A summary of each of the above losses was provided to RMC on November 20, 2018.

The documents supporting these damages are included in the documents produced by FCStone.
