ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF THE INSURANCE REHABILITATOR FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUR-REPLY TO DEBTOR'S REPLY IN SUPPORT OF DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR FINAL ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 105(A), 362, AND 541 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE (I) ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR (A) CERTAIN TRANSFERS OF EQUITY INTERESTS, AND (B) TAKING OR IMPLEMENTING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS AFFECTING THE INTERESTS OF THE DEBTOR, AND (II) SCHEDULING A FINAL HEARING, FILED AUGUST 16, 2013 AND TO SHORTEN NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO SAME

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of Andrew Boron, Director of Insurance of the State of Illinois, in his capacity as statutory and court-affirmed rehabilitator appointed under Article XIII of the Illinois Insurance Code (215 ILCS 5/187 *et seq.*) (in such capacity, the "Rehabilitator") for Triad Guaranty Insurance Corporation and Triad Guaranty Assurance Corporation, seeking leave to file a sur-reply (the "Sur Reply") in response to the Debtor's Reply in Support of Debtor's Motion for Final Order Pursuant to Sections 105(a), 362, and 541 of the Bankruptcy Code (i) Establishing Procedures for (a) Certain Transfers of Equity Interests, and (b) Taking or Implementing Certain Other Actions Affecting the Interests of the Debtor, and (ii) Scheduling a Final Hearing, filed August 16, 2013 (Docket No. 116) (the "Reply") and seek shortened notice in connection with same; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein in accordance with §§ 157 and 1334; and after due deliberation, and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is granted.
2. The request to shorten notice is granted and the Sur-Reply attached to the Motion as Exhibit 1 shall be deemed filed on the docket upon the entry of this order.
