**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR’S MOTION TO SHORTEN NOTICE OF  
INTERIM HEARING ON MOTION FOR INTERIM AND FINAL ORDER

It is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that:

1. The Motion to Shorten is granted as set forth herein.
