FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**


Upon consideration of the fee applications (collectively, the “Applications”) for final allowance of fees for professional services and disbursements incurred in this case by the professionals identified on the attached Exhibit A (the “Applicants”), pursuant to the Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals and Official Committee Members (the “Compensation Order”); and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Applications; and this Court having determined that proper and adequate notice of the Applications has been given and that no other or further notice is required; and it further appearing that no party asserted any objection to any of the Applications; and it further appearing that the compensation and reimbursement requested in the Applications is reasonable and necessary; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby ordered that:

1. The Applications are granted, as set forth herein.
2. The fees and expenses of the Applicants are allowed on a final basis in the amounts set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

3. The Debtor is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Applicants the allowed amounts set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto to the extent not already paid pursuant to the Compensation Order.

4. This Court shall, and hereby does, retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
