**ORDER SCHEDULING EXPEDITED HEARING**

Upon the motion (the “Motion”)<sup>2</sup> of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) for the entry of an order (this “Order”) scheduling an expedited hearing on the Debtors’ First Day Matters; and it appearing that the relief requested therein is in the best interests of the Debtors’ estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that notice of the Motion and opportunity for a hearing on the Motion was appropriate



under the particular circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.

2. A hearing will be held on the First Day Matters on July 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. (prevailing Eastern time) before the Honorable Ashely Chan, United States Bankruptcy Judge, presiding at the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal Courthouse, 900 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107, courtroom #5.

3. Objections to the First Day Matters may be filed prior to, or presented orally at, the hearing on July 6, 2017.

4. A copy of this Order, the Motion and the underlying motions related to the First Day Matters shall be served via overnight mail, facsimile or electronic mail no later than noon on Monday, July 1, 2017 on: the U.S. Trustee, the IRS, the Commonwealth of PA, the City of Philadelphia, all secured creditors, Play and Learn, the landlord under the Ford Road Lease, the top 30 unsecured creditors and all parties who have requested notice pursuant to F.R.B.P. 2002.

5. A certificate of service stating that service was made in accordance with P 4 above shall be filed no later than July 5, 2017.
