**NOTICE OF MOTION, RESPONSE DEADLINE AND HEARING DATE
RELATED TO APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF DILWORTH PAXSON LLP
AS COUNSEL FOR THE DEBTORS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on June 30, 2017, the above-captioned debtors (the “Debtors”) filed *Debtors’ Application Of The Debtors Pursuant To Section 327(a) Of The Bankruptcy Code For Authority To Employ Dilworth Paxson LLP As Counsel For The Debtors* (D.I. 4) and related papers with the Court seeking an entry of Order granting Debtor’s Motion.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult an attorney.

If you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought in the Motion, or if you want the Court to consider your views on the Motion, then on or before **July 14, 2017**, you or your attorney must do all of the following:

(a) file an Objection explaining your position at Clerk’s Office, Room 400, 900 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, 19107. If you mail your Objection to the Bankruptcy Clerk’s Office for filing, you must mail it early enough so that it will be received on or before the date and time stated above; and

2. If you or your attorney do not take the steps described in Paragraphs 1(a) & 1(b) above, the Court may enter an Order granting relief requested in the Motion.

3. In the absence of a timely filing and service of an objection, the Debtor will request the Court to consider and approve the Motion without hearing or further notice.

4. If a copy of the Motion is not enclosed, a copy of the Motion will be provided to you if you request a copy from Anne M. Aaronson, whose address is below.

5. You may contact the Bankruptcy Clerk's Office at 215-408-2800 to find out whether the hearing has been canceled because no one filed a Response.
