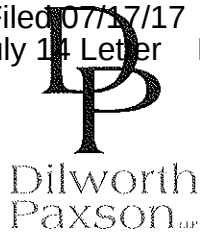

Dear Mr. Baki:

Please be advised that Wordsworth Academy, Wordsworth CUA 5, LLC and Wordsworth CUA 10, LLC (collectively, the "Debtors") filed voluntary Chapter 11 bankruptcy petitions in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania on June 30, 2017. The Debtors' bankruptcy cases are jointly administered under the Wordsworth Academy caption as case no. 17-14463 (AMC). This firm is counsel to the Debtors.

I understand that you performed IT services for Wordsworth until recently and that you have not been paid for prepetition services. The Debtors are prohibited by law from paying you for services rendered prepetition.

I also understand that you have in your possession administrative access credentials which allow access to the Debtors' computer systems and super administrative passwords and usernames for those systems (collectively the "Passwords") and have refused to provide the Passwords to the Debtors.

The Passwords are property of the Debtors' bankruptcy estates pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 541. As such, your failure to turn over the Passwords as requested by the Debtors is a violation of the automatic stay of 11 U.S.C. § 362.


Further, 11 U.S.C. § 362(k) provides for damages, including costs and attorney fees, as well as punitive damages in appropriate circumstances, for willful violations of the automatic stay.

The Debtors hereby demand that you provide the Passwords to the Debtors in writing no later than the close of business on Monday, July 17, 2017. In the event you fail to do so, the Debtors intend to seek damages for violation of the stay in the Bankruptcy Court.
