**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF  
WEIR & PARTNERS LLP AS CO-COUNSEL  
TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED  
CREDITORS *NUNC PRO TUNC* TO JULY 21, 2017**

Upon consideration of the application (the "Application") of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee"), appointed pursuant to section 1103 of title 11 of the United States Code, in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases of of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), authorizing the Committee to employ and retain Weir & Partners LLP ("Weir") as its co-counsel, *nunc pro tunc* to July 21, 2017, and upon the Declaration of Jeffrey S. Cianciulli, Esquire annexed thereto, and it appearing that proper notice of the Application has been given and that no further notice or hearing is required, and the Court being satisfied based on the representations made in the Application and declaration that (i) Weir represents no interest adverse to the Debtors' estates, creditors, or equity holders, (ii) Weir, to the extent required, is a "disinterested person" as that term is defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code, and (iii) the employment of Weir is necessary and would be in the best interest of the Committee and the Debtors and their estates, and after due deliberation, and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that in accordance with section 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Committee be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to employ and retain Weir as co-counsel, *nunc pro tunc* to July 21, 2017, to represent the Committee in this case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, and it is further

**ORDERED** that Weir shall be compensated in accordance with the procedures set forth in sections 330 and 331 of title 11 of the United States and such Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure as may be then applicable, from time to time, and such procedures as may be fixed by Order of this Court.
