**NOTICE OF MOTION, RESPONSE DEADLINE, AND HEARING DATE**

Martin Canady and Brooke Diggs (“Movants”) have filed a Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay with the Court to permit Movants to proceed with their State Court Civil Action proceeding against Debtor, Wordsworth CUA 5, in the matter captioned as *Canady, et al. v. Green, et al.* at April Term, 2016, No.: 00433 in the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to contact an attorney.)

1. If you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought in the motion or if you want the court to consider your views on the motion, then or before August 30, 2017, you or your attorney must do all of the following:

- (a) file an answer explaining your position with:

2. If you or your attorney do not take these steps described in paragraphs

1(a) and 1(b) above and attend the hearing, the court may enter an order granting the relief requested in the motion.

3. A hearing on the motion is scheduled to be held before the Honorable Ashley M. Chan on September 6, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. in Courtroom #5, United States Bankruptcy Court, Robert N.C. Nix Sr. Federal Courthouse, 900 Market Street, Suite 201, Philadelphia, PA 19107.

4. If a copy of the motion is not enclosed, a copy of the motion will be provided to you if you request a copy from the attorney named in paragraph 1(b).

5. You may contact the Bankruptcy Clerk's office at **(215) 408-2800** to find out whether the hearing has been cancelled because no one filed an answer.
