**STIPULATION REGARDING CONTINUANCE OF MOTION
FOR RELIEF FROM STAY FILED BY MARVIN CANADY AND BROOKE DIGGS**

RECITALS

A. On June 30, 2017 (the "Petition Date"), Debtors Wordsworth Academy, Wordsworth CUA5 and Wordsworth CUA10 (collectively, the "Debtors") each commenced a case under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania ("Court").

B. On or about August 11, 2017, Marvin Canady and Brooke Diggs (collectively the "Movants") filed a Motion for Relief From the Automatic Stay (The "Stay Relief Motion").

C. The Movants and the Debtors have entered into a Stipulation to resolve the Stay Relief Motion ("The Stay Relief Stipulation"), and the Debtors intend to seek approval of the Stay Relief Stipulation pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9010.


D. The Movants have consented to extend the period in which a preliminary and final hearing on the Stay Relief Motion may be held.

AGREEMENT


1. The parties hereby agree that the hearing on the Stay Relief Motion shall be continued to October 25, 2017 at 11:00 a.m.
