OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS**

The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “**Committee**”) has filed the *Motion for Partial Reconsideration of the Order Authorizing and Approving the Employment and Retention of Cullen and Dykman LLP as Counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* (the “**Motion**”) with the Court for entry of an order amending the Court’s Retention Order, entered on September 20, 2017, to deem Cullen and Dykman’s retention effective as of July 17, 2017.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult an attorney.)

1. If you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought in the Motion or if you want the Court to consider your views on the motion, then on or before 10/19/17 you or your attorney must do all of the following:

2. If you or your attorney do not take the steps described in paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) above and attend the hearing, the Court may enter an order granting the relief requested in the Motion.

3. A hearing on the Motion is scheduled to be held before the Honorable Ashely M. Chan on 11/01/17, at 11:00 a.m. in Courtroom No. 5, United States Bankruptcy Court, Robert N.C. Nix Federal Building & Courthouse, 900 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

4. If a copy of the Motion is not enclosed, a copy of the Motion will be provided to you if you request a copy from the attorney named in paragraph 1(b).
