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**ORDER APPROVING INCREASED SALARY  
OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER/CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER *NUNC PRO TUNC*  
TO JULY 1, 2017 PURSUANT TO LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 4002-1**

Upon the motion (the “Motion”)<sup>2</sup> of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) for the entry of an order (this “Order”) authorizing the Debtors to pay an increased salary to Donald Stewart (“Mr. Stewart”) in his capacity as debtor Wordsworth Academy’s Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer, *nunc pro tunc* to July 1, 2017; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A), (M), and/or (O); and it appearing that venue for this matter is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that notice of the Motion was appropriate under the circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and, after due deliberation, it appearing that there is cause for the relief requested under Local Bankruptcy Rule 4002-1(a) and that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtors’ estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.

2. The Debtors are authorized to pay Mr. Stewart an annual salary of \$175,000, retroactive to July 1, 2017.

3. Mr. Stewart's other compensation and benefits shall remain the same, except to the extent that modifications thereto are authorized by the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and/or other orders of this Court, including any order with respect to insurance or other employment benefits, and/or to the extent modified by the Debtors in the ordinary course of their business.

4. The Debtors are authorized and empowered to take any and all actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.

5. Notwithstanding the possible application of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(h), or otherwise, the terms of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
