**ORDER REGARDING APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT OF  
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIM OF GEORGE JUNIOR REPUBLIC**

AND NOW, upon consideration of (1) the Application For Payment of Administrative Expense Claim (the “Application”) filed by George Junior Republic (“George Junior”), (2) the objection to the Application filed by the above-captioned debtors (the “Debtors”), and (3) the agreement of the parties with respect to the resolution of the Application on the terms set forth herein, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED as follows:


1. The Application is granted in part and denied in part as set forth herein.
2. George Junior’s administrative expense claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503 is allowed (a) against Wordsworth CUA 10, LLC in the amount of \$1,676.37 and (b) against Wordsworth CUA 5, LLC in the amount of \$2,317.61, for a total of \$3,993.98. The administrative expense claim is disallowed to the extent it exceeds the total of \$3,993.98.
3. The allowance of the administrative expense claim as set forth in this order is without prejudice to the rights of any party with respect to (a) any prepetition claims or (b) any
