Doug,


I have reviewed your letter and determined that the proposal you mentioned was blended together with your old proposal given in the late afternoon on July 17, 2018, and we discussed your proposal. If you recall, on July 18, 2018, you, Joe Micheletti, and I held many discussions most of the day concerning an extension agreement. We reached said extension on July 19, 2018 at approximately 4:30 p.m. Shortly after the July 19, 2018 negotiations and extension I suggested we, the bargaining team, form a sub-committee of the negotiation team to address the need to remove several million yards of dirt at the mine to uncover much needed coal to keep the customers of the Kemmerer Mine happy. And on July 24-25, 2018 we did just that and finalized an agreement, which is in full force. The project to remove extra dirt is doing well and the Local Union and I are monitoring the progress each and every day. I have on at least two occasions discussed this issue with your mine manager.

Pursuant to the bankruptcy code, the criteria for bargaining is clearly outlined and Westmoreland should make a request under the appropriate venue.

It sure is interesting that you have not reached out to me to set up any bargaining (usually in the past by a phone call) until I get the attached note (certified no less) the same week that your company notified the Union on October 7, 2018 that they were filing bankruptcy and they did file on October 9, 2018. Because of your letter, and your company filing bankruptcy, I would

suggest all future bargaining correspondence should be directed to the President of the United Mine Workers of America, Cecil Roberts (18354 Quantico Gateway Drive, Suite 200, Triangle, VA 22172).

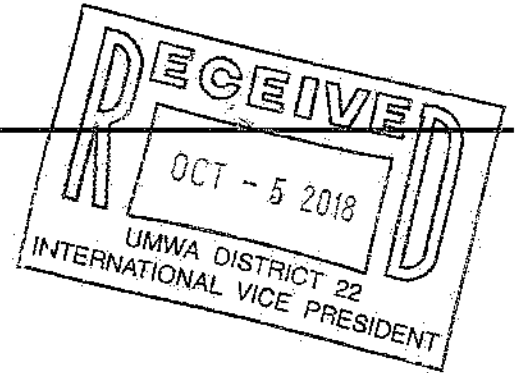

Re: Bargaining dates for next meeting


Dear Mike:

On July 18, 2018, the Union and Westmoreland Coal Company met as part of ongoing negotiations. During that meeting, Westmoreland provided the Union with comprehensive proposals regarding the various issues the Company needs to address going forward with its operation of the Kemmerer mine. After the presentation of the Company proposals, the Union stated it needed more time to review and respond to these proposals. To date, we have not received a response from the Union on any of these proposals.

Although, the Union and Company next met on July 24, 2018, to discuss language for an optional shift length change for the remainder of the year, there was no discussion on the Company proposals at this meeting. Rather, the parties reached agreement on the shift change.

Since the time of our last meeting, the Company, in consultation with its lenders, has revised certain of its proposals that are necessary for the Company to successfully reorganize. We are prepared to present these modified proposals at our next meeting. As you know, our extension agreement requires that the parties meet to bargain a new contract. Accordingly, Westmoreland is available to meet and bargain in good faith this month on the following dates: October 9, 10, 11 and 12, October 25 - 26 and October 29 through November 1. Please let me know if the Union is available to meet on these dates.
