

Dear Honorable David R. Jones:

We are writing this letter to state our concerns about the bankruptcy of Westmoreland Coal Company and its effect upon the workers, their pensions, and health care benefits. This is affecting the type of medical care we receive. The company, through contract to its workers, made a promise to the UMWA that it would provide health care benefits and pensions for its retirees. If through this bankruptcy, the company is allowed to default on its responsibilities, many will suffer. I take 8 medications daily and my wife takes 10 (two of which, are for the heart). The cost for one of these is \$489 and that is only one out of eighteen. We cannot afford this and we would have to decide whether to buy groceries or take our medication. It will also affect if we can even see our doctors for proper health care. We are asking that you take all of these things in consideration when you make your decision about the bankruptcy. Thank you!
